

Bryan Dutt

In 1999 G. Bryan Dutt founded Ironman Energy Capital, an energy hedge fund headquartered in Houston, Texas. The Ironman PI (Private and Illiquid) Fund, which is registered with the Securities and Exchange Commission, was founded in 2007 and invests in highly illiquid and private securities in the energy industry.

Prior to his work with Ironman, Dutt was a managing partner at Centennial Energy Partners from 1995 to 1999. He spent 10 years at Howard Weil, an energy "boutique" investment firm located in New Orleans. While at Howard Weil he completed approximately 50 capital transactions and eventually was promoted to supervisory analyst leading the Exploration and Production Team. Before Howard Weil, he was an energy analyst at Wood Mackenzie. Dutt also spent two years as a geologist for Baker International (now Baker Hughes).

Mr. Dutt is a Chartered Financial Analyst, is past president of the New Orleans Financial Analyst Society, is a founding member of the Capital Market Group for the Independent Petroleum Association of America, and is a member of various professional organizations.

Bryan Dutt received degrees in both Geology and Economics at Colgate University and received an MBA in Finance from Tulane University where he was awarded a Freeman Fellowship.
