

Arthur P. Brief

Arthur P. Brief received his Ph.D. from the University of Wisconsin-Madison in 1974 and currently is the Lawrence Martin Chair of Business at Tulane's A. B. Freeman School of Business, with a courtesy appointment in the Department of Psychology. He also is Director of the William B. and Evelyn Burkenroad Institute for the Study of Ethics and Leadership in Management. Prior to his move to Tulane in 1989, Professor Brief was on the faculties of several other schools including, most recently, New York University's Stern School of Business. In addition to lecturing throughout the United States, he has taught organizational behavior in Chile, Finland, France, Italy, Mexico, People's Republic of China, Taiwan, and elsewhere internationally. During the fall of 1995, Professor Brief was in Lisbon as the Fulbright/FLAD Chair of Organizational Behavior. In 2003, he was a Batten Fellow at the University of Virginia's Darden Graduate School of Business Administration.

Professor Brief is a recipient of the Freeman School's most prized award for teaching, the Wissner Award, and the Academic Leadership Award from the Aspen Institute's Initiative for Social Innovation through Business and the World Resources Institute for integrating social and environmental concerns into business education. His scholarship, which focuses on two areas - job related distress and ethical decision making in organizations, also has been award winning. His books, among others, include Task Design and Employee Motivation, Managing Job Stress, Productivity Research in the Behavioral and Social Sciences, Meanings of Occupational Work: A Collection of Essays, and, most recently, Attitudes In and Around Organizations.

Professor Brief was Co-Editor of Lexington Book's series "Issues in Organization and Management" and Editor of a series of ancestral books in administrative science for Garland Publishing Co. and, currently, is Co-Editor of Lawrence Erlbaum Associates' Organization and Management Series. He has served on the Editorial Boards of the Academy of Management Journal, other learned journals, and currently, he is a member of the Editorial Boards of the Journal of Applied Psychology and Organizational Behavior and Human Decision Processes. In January, 2003, Professor Brief became the Editor of the Academy of Management Review. He is a Fellow of the Academy of Management, the American Psychological Association, and the American Psychological Society as well as a member of the Society of Organizational Behavior. Professor Brief has served as the Chair of the Academy of Management's Organizational Behavior Division.

As well as being an educator, researcher, and editor, Professor Brief has been an active advisor to management in the human resources area.
