NEW ORLEANS MAYOR RAY NAGIN ADDRESSES GRADUATES

The Honorable C. Ray Nagin (MBA '94), mayor of New Orleans, encouraged Freeman School graduates to put their newly developed skills to work building a better New Orleans. “The business school you are graduating from teaches you skills to make the world better,” said Nagin, an alumnus of the executive MBA program. “I ask that you consider staying in New Orleans and helping us. We need strong will, a game plan and young talent like yourselves.”

Nagin, recipient of the Outstanding Alumnus Award, addressed graduates at the 2002 Freeman School diploma ceremony, which took place at the Municipal Auditorium in New Orleans on May 18, 2002. It immediately

followed the university-wide commencement ceremony in the Louisiana Superdome.

Nagin, the former vice president and general manager of Cox Communications in southeast Louisiana, took office as the 51st mayor of New Orleans two weeks before the ceremony. At Cox, Nagin led the revival of one of the largest media companies in the nation, serving more than 700,000 people. Through his focus on customer expansion, revenue growth and service performance development, Cox increased its customer level by more than 85,000. Nagin, a native of New Orleans, earned a Bachelor of Science in 1978 from Tuskegee University.

Also addressing the audience at the ceremony were 2002 graduates David Shapiro, Karla Gordillo, Emily Stern and Joseph Richberg, who represented the undergraduate and graduate student bodies.

The Freeman School handed out diplomas to 352 new graduates at the ceremony, including 261 BSMs, seven MACCTs and 84 MBAs.

The ceremony also included the naming of this year's student award winners. Danna H. Atie was the winner of this year's BSM Scholastic Achievement Award, which recognizes the Bachelor of Science in Management graduate with the

highest cumulative grade point average. Erik I. Dane received the Marta and Peter Bordeaux Scholastic Achievement Award, which recognizes the MBA graduate with the highest cumulative grade point average.

THE PINBALL WIZARD

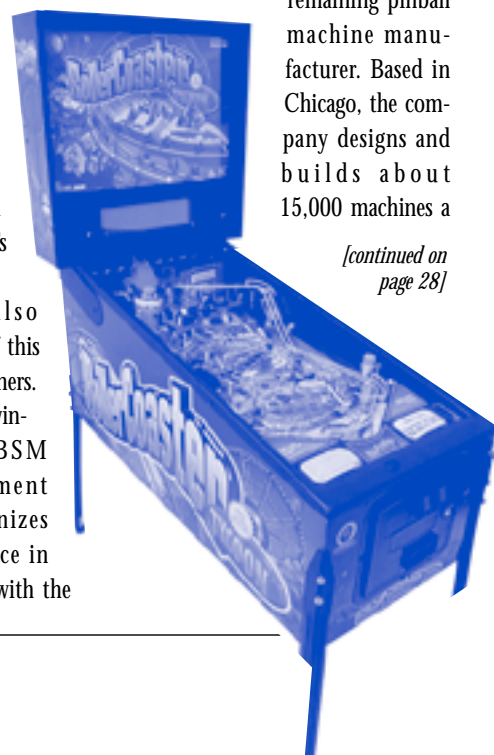
Gary Stern (BBA '67) may be the only CEO in America who requires his employees to take a 15-minute break every afternoon at work. To play pinball.

No, it's not the latest motivational technique from a hot management guru. It's technical research. “We need the computer statistics out of the game of how different players are playing,” Stern says. “It's part of the job.”

Stern is president of Stern Pinball Inc., which since 1999 has carried the flag as the world's sole remaining pinball machine manufacturer. Based in Chicago, the company designs and builds about 15,000 machines a

year for devotees of the mechanical forerunner to today's video games.

According to Stern, while pinball may evoke nostalgic images of malt shops and drive-ins, today's new, high-tech machines are designed to appeal to contemporary players. "Pinball is retro," Stern says. "A '78 Volkswagen Beetle is nostalgic but a new Beetle is retro. It's the same with our games. We make a different game than was made all those years ago."

If anyone could be said to have pinball in his blood, it's Gary Stern. His father, Sam Stern, began his career as a pinball game operator and distributor in Philadelphia in the 1930s. He eventually became president and owner of Williams, one of the industry's biggest players.

"I think my father thought I should go straight, but I always

liked the gaming business," Stern says.

Stern toyed with the idea of going straight. After earning his JD from Northwestern in 1971, he practiced law for several years before joining his father at Williams in 1973. He worked with his father until 1976, when he took over Chicago Coin, another gaming company. Stern operated Chicago Coin until 1984. In 1986 he started a new pinball subsidiary for the Japanese firm Data East Corp. Sega bought Data East Pinball in 1994, and in 1999, Stern bought the company back from Sega, becoming the world's sole pinball manufacturer.

Pinball has shot in and out of favor many times over the years. While Stern says business has rebounded slightly from a down-

turn in the mid-'90s, he doesn't expect to be facing new competition any time soon. "The pinball business is a very mature business," Stern says. "It has bottomed out, but it's still significantly smaller than it was 10 years ago when there were four or five of us making pinball machines. There's only room for one pinball company."

Today, Stern and his 56 full-time employees oversee an operation that produces about 15,000 machines a year. About half of them are exported to Europe. France is Stern's largest export market with Italy a close second.

Licensing is still the name of the game when it comes to pinball. In recent years, Stern Pinball has scored with machines based on the television show *South Park*, Harley Davidson motorcycles, the Austin

Powers movies, *Playboy* magazine and the board game Monopoly. In the fall of 2002, the company unveiled a new machine based on the popular Roller Coaster Tycoon computer game. "It has an amusement park theme," Stern says. "For us, it's perfect. Think of the ramps on a pinball machine and then think of roller coasters. It's just a great game."

And before you jump to conclusions, Stern says that despite his 30 years in the industry, he's still no wizard when it comes to flipping the flippers. "I'm old and slow," he says of his personal pinball prowess. "A lot of our games are in taverns and sometimes people have had a few drinks. Somebody has to represent the customer whose reaction time has been slowed. I represent that customer."
